

## Savannah River

**1.** The 600 block of Abercorn Street - Parade performers aren't tired yet. The bands step higher; people waving from their floats aren't yet suffering from arm fatigue.

**2.** The Grand Marshal's reviewing stand (where the band winners are presented with their trophies) is on Bull Street between Liberty and Harris streets. Parade participants save their best performances for the grand marshal and other dignitaries, so you're guaranteed a great show.

**3.** East Broad Street (Broughton to Bay streets) - A good place to witness the picturesque variety of parade spectators. One year, several green dogs were spotted. SCAD students tend to be in full bloom around here.

**4.** Bay Street (from East Broad to Bull streets) - most convenient spot for those who've been cavorting - or plan to cavort - down by the river.

**5.** Kelly Tours will have bleacher seating for sale in three areas along the parade route:

- a.** The Cathedral of St. John the Baptist at Liberty and Abercorn streets;
- b.** Colonial Cemetery at Abercorn Street and Oglethorpe Avenue; and
- c.** Factors Walk on Bay Street.
